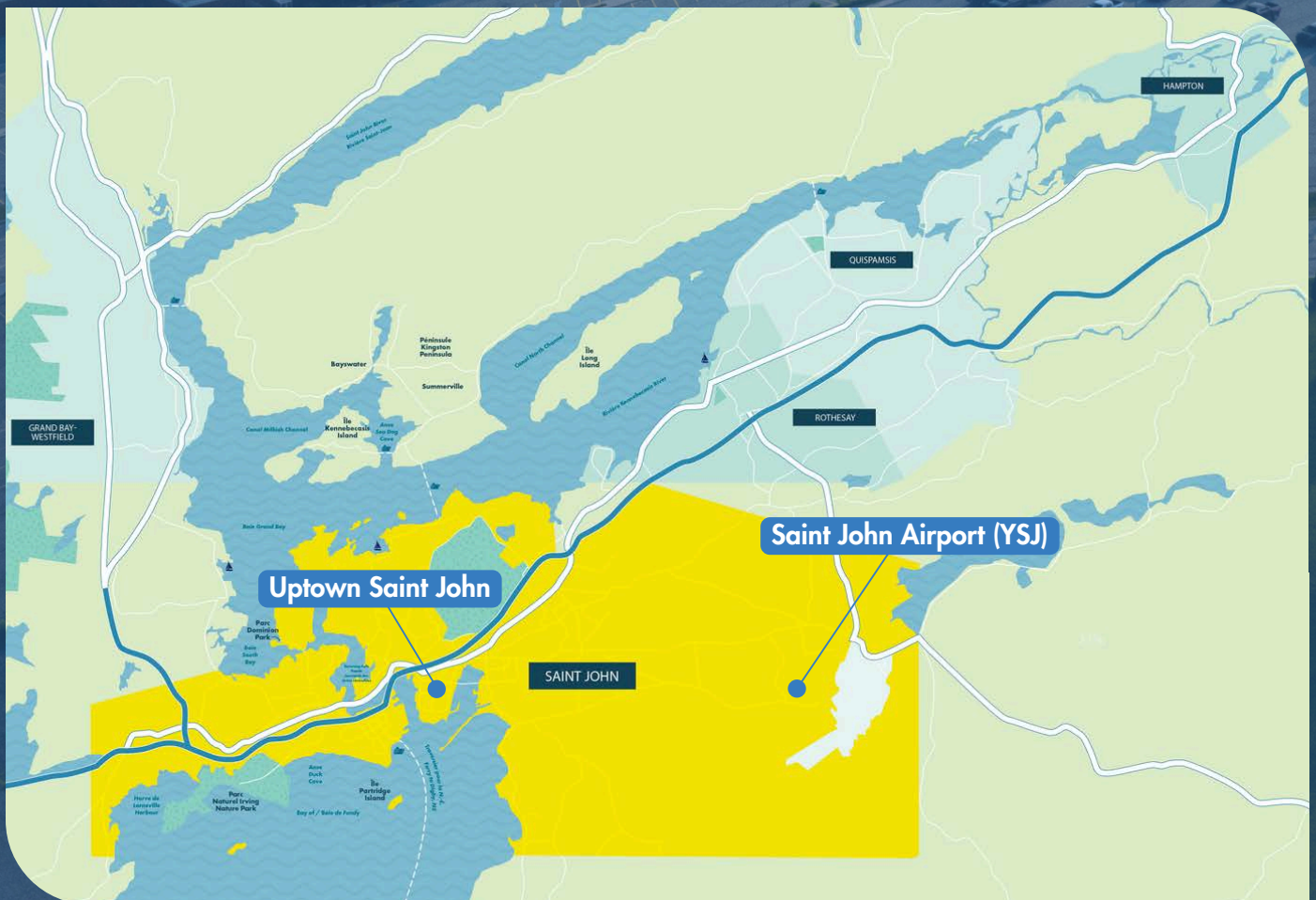


# AIR ACCESS

- Halifax Stanfield International Airport (YHZ) - 3.5 hours from uptown Saint John

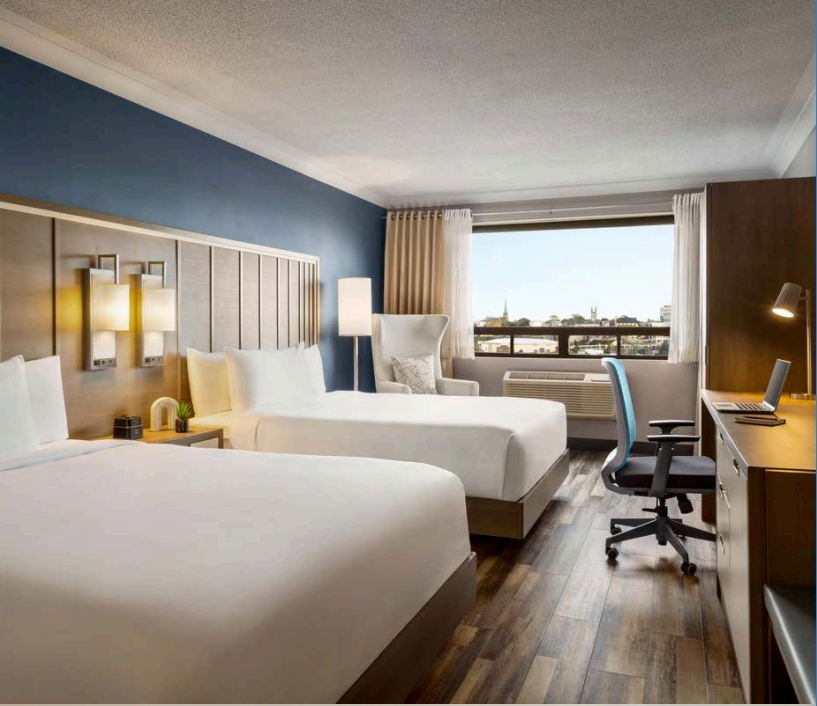
